JEWELLERY, MAKE UP AND HAIRSTYLES

- Jewellery should be kept to a minimum (a watch, plain stud earrings, discreet and hidden necklaces, one simple ring, but no bracelets and no other visible piercings, including stretchers etc.)
- The only make up allowed is **light** mascara, (nail varnish, eye shadow, eye liner, lipstick, foundation etc. should not be worn)
- Hairstyles should not be extreme in terms of style or colour

- Sweat pants, jeans, combats, cords
- Headwear such as caps and bandanas, with the exception of students whose religion requires head covering
